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## Junior Guidelines for Winter 2009 season

1. Players are responsible for payment to their own Centre
2. Players who are unable to play are to advise their own Centre and where they are due to play as soon as possible.
3. Players must be ready to commence play at 9.00AM \*\* Forfeits will apply at the discretion of the centre operator starting at 9.15AM with the lowest position. A match may be forfeited every 15 minutes.
4. If a reserve player has not been arranged then a player may play twice but may only play their match and the position higher in their own team. Please note: **Sliding rules for Juniors in same team**  
Where a Centre is unable to field a full Junior team:-
  - i) a player having played in his or her own position within a team, may fill-in in a higher position in his or her own team but may not play in a position higher than any other player registered above him or her;
  - ii) it shall be limited to 5 times the number of times such a player may fill-in (play twice) in his or her own team;
  - iii) all matches played by a fill-in player shall count towards that team's results as if the missing player had played in that team personally; and
  - iv) all matches played by a fill-in player shall count towards the number of matches required for that player to be eligible to play in a finals series.

Also note: **Sliding rules for Juniors where more than one team in grade.** Where a Centre has two or more teams in the same Junior grade:-

  - v) a player from one of those teams may slide for any one or more of the other teams in the grade whether or not he or she is playing for his or her own team; and
  - vi) a player from one of those teams may slide for more than one of the other teams in the grade on the same day; except that –
  - vii) any player sliding across to another team may only play in the same or a higher position as the one in which he or she plays in his or her own team;
  - viii) a player filling-in may play more than one position in the team in which he or she is a fill-in;
  - ix) there shall be limit of 5 times such a player may fill-in for any other team in his or her own grade;
  - x) all matches played by a fill-in player shall count towards that team's results as if the player had been registered in that team;
  - xi) all matches played by a fill-in player shall count towards the number of matches required for that player to be eligible to play in a finals series; and
  - xii) A player must play 5 times to be eligible for a final series.
5. Players are to determine their order of play. Play does not have to be 3-2-1
6. Scoring will be Point A Rally **PAR 11** for **Colts and J4** and **TRADITIONAL** (hand out to 9) for **J2 and J3** – ALL Best of 5 GAMES.
7. The DUNLOP double yellow dot ball will be used for all matches.
8. The Winning team will be decided on Games then Points then Rubbers.
9. **Eligibility based on age for Junior Pennants Competition**
  - i) To be eligible to compete in the Junior **Colts** grade, players must be **under 23 years** of age as at the 31st December of the competing year;
  - ii) To be eligible to compete in the Junior **J2** grade players must be **under 19 years** of age as at the 31st December of the competing year; and
  - iii) To be eligible to compete in the Junior **J3 and J4** grade players must be **under 17 years** of age as at the 31st December of the competing year
10. Grand Final will commence at 9.00AM (Colts grade 8.30am)
11. Next season commences on 10th October 2009.

### Proof of age for Junior Pennants Competitions

Centre operators need to provide the date of birth of all their junior players to the administrator of River City Squash when submitting teams or as soon as practicable after the competition has commenced.
